**Discussion:**

- **Barracudas**
  - Proposal sent to board. After submitting the information they wanted, the proposal was approved.
  - The swim team meets were approved with an additional provision for the swim meets if the fences are not installed in time.
  - The barracudas will be responsible for finding volunteers and working with Kuester to secure their swim team to the lap pool only. (so that the activity pull may remain open and fully utilized by the membership)
  - Team has not selected a coaching staff yet.
- **Update on Swim lessons for next year**
  - BDA has declined to provide lessons
  - BDA sent a letter ou telling residents
  - Jeremy at Kuester is looking for instructors
  - AMG has offered to help with swim lessons

- **Pool warming/Fence**
  - Need the fence for swim meets AMG will try to work with BCCA with us on the fence and heater
  - Exploring to turn off activity pool for winter to heat lap pool

## **Pool Opening for 2022 discussion**

### **Last year was as follows**

The pools will open on May 10 with weekday hours from 4 pm to 8 pm, when lifeguards will be present. On weekends the pools will be open from 10 am to 8 pm with lifeguards.

SAYOR is for registrants (18 years and older). The Committee will recommend to the Board the following schedule:

- May 10 through June 9: Weekdays: Lap Pool and Activity Pool 6 am – 3pm. Weekends and Holidays: Lap Pool and Activity Pool 6 am – 9 am
  - June 10 through July 31: Weekdays: Lap Pool (All Lanes) 6 am – 7am; (Two Lanes) 7:30 -10:30 am. Weekends and Holidays (including July 2 and July 5) Lap Pool and Activity Pool 6 am – 9 am
  - August 1 through August 22: Weekdays and Weekends: Lap Pool and Activity Pool 6 am – 9 am
  - August 23 through September 12: Weekdays: 6 am – 3 pm; Weekends and Holidays: 6 am – 9 am.
  - Pool opens June 10. From June 10 through July 31, the Swim Team will have use of 6 of the 8 lanes in the lap pool from 7:30 am to 10:30 am on weekdays (except Friday, July 2 and Monday, July 5). Two lanes will be open to the general membership for lap swimming only. The activity pool opens at 10:00am.
  - Capacity last year was Activity pool = 300 Lap pool = 150
- **Recommendation**
    - Keep what we did last year with date adjustment.
    - Make any adjustments needed.
    - When water is stable- may open for SAYOR
